I: This is Bob Smith with ABC News. We are in Kabuto City today. Many high school students are doing volunteer work here. Let's talk to one of them now. [pause] Excuse me, may I ask you some questions?

M: Oh, sure.

I: Thank you. I'm Bob, by the way.

M: I'm Manabu Seki.

I: Hi, Manabu! So, why are you here?

M: I am here to help clean the city. Last week, my teacher told us Kabuto City had a lot of trouble after the earthquake. My friend said to me, "Let's go help!", so I came here with him.

I: Thanks for helping clean the city. How did you feel when you first came here?

M: Well, I knew there was a lot of damage from the earthquake, but seeing many broken houses and cars with my own eyes was very surprising. I also saw other things on the ground, like trees, parts of stone walls and traffic lights.

I: I see. So, what are you doing now to help?

M: Well, there are also a lot of plastic bottles, broken glass, and paper on the streets. We are picking up such garbage. It is hard work, but many people from Kabuto City smile and say "thank you" when they see us. I feel warm inside because of their smiles.

I: That's great! Other students like you are helping out. Have you talked to them?

M: Yeah, actually, it's fun to meet many students from all over Japan. I made some new friends today.

I: That's nice. Do you have a final message?

M: I think we should continue to support Kabuto City. Some people can't get enough food and they don't have a place to sleep. There are still a lot of things to do here, so more students should *come* and *help*. In the future, I want to come back again because, when we help people, they become happy and we also become happy.

I: That's so true. Thank you, Manabu, for answering our questions.
