One day, I joined an activity that used *blocks. The teacher said, "You have six different blocks in a bag. Make a bird with the six blocks. You have one minute! Start." After a minute, every bird had a different shape. The teacher said, "Each bird was different, but correct and wonderful. We all have different ideas because we are all unique." I was impressed by these words, and I became very interested in the small blocks we used.

Later, I found out the blocks were called LEGO. I discovered that LEGO is *officially the most respected *brand on the planet. At the start of 2017, the yearly *rankings showed the world's top 500 most *reputable brands. LEGO was at the very top of that list. Some people think that LEGO is now more respected than Apple, Disney and even Google. 1)______, for the past 90 years, the LEGO company hasn't always been successful. It had many hard times, but it recovered every time. I wanted to know more about the company.

The name LEGO came from the *Danish words "leg godt." In English this means "play well." The company started to make toys made of wood in Denmark in 1932. In those days, the wooden toys were heavy and expensive. Some years later, they invented toys made of plastic because it was light and cheap. It was also easy to make toys of the same size by using plastic.

The *founder of the company always told his family and workers, *"Inspire and develop the builders of tomorrow." He asked, "What can we do for children? 2) <u>What would the world be like if our company disappeared?</u> Would it be the same or different?" He believed that the company had to make toys which develop children's imaginations. From this idea, they invented a small plastic block. It had a big impact on the world of toys. 3) <u>It</u> became possible for children to make cars, castles, and airplanes.

The little blocks became more and more popular, and they made children around the world happier and happier. However, in the late 1980s, the block's *patent *expired. Many toy companies began to make similar blocks, and their prices were much lower than those of LEGO. 4)______, LEGO blocks didn't sell well. At around the same time, video games also became popular. LEGO was disappearing from the world of toys. To survive, the company decided to not only sell LEGO but also enter various industries and fields. For example, it started the business of developing video games, producing television programs, and building theme parks. However, they all failed. LEGO was dying.

In 2004, the new boss of LEGO thought deeply about changing his company. In the end, he focused only on LEGO and the founder's idea: "What can we do for society? What can we do for our children? How can we develop children's imaginations?" He hoped the world would know how wonderful and useful LEGO is. They decided to focus on making more original LEGO blocks. They also introduced some made of *renewable plastic.

Once again LEGO became one of the world's best toys. After many difficulties, the company looked back at itself and asked what the world would be like without it. I think LEGO has taught us that there is no single answer in our lives, and that we should look at our own strong points when we have difficulties. Thank you for listening.


