授業目的/Course Purpose	Extending the course 'Introduction to European Economic History' that ends with a class on the destruction of Europe's economy during the 2nd World War, this course will focus solely on the post-war development of the European economy and on the process of European economic integration. With this focus, the course intends to especially highlight the economic effects of European integration beginning with the European Coal and Steel Community in 1952 until the recent Euro crisis in 2009/10 and its aftermath. The genuine purpose and aim of this course is to present European economic integration to students not as an inevitable, smooth process, but as an often very difficult one accompanied by various crises, which so far, however, have all been resolved due to a shared perception amongst member states that European integration provides an overall added value to all member states, for which to achieve sometimes also sacrifices are necessary to make. The applied perspective of the course is an economic historical one, focusing particularly on issues how living standards and living conditions of Europeans have changed due to the European project.		
授業目的(英文)/Course Purpose	See above		
到達目標/Learning Goals	Students are to acquire a broad general knowledge about the European Union's economic development from the 1950s until today. Students should know the main steps of European economic integration and should be able to explain the main economic effects of this integration process. Students should become aware of the many difficulties and obstacles with which the EU and its member states have been constantly confronted with in their efforts to further pursue European integration. This knowledge should enable students also to put economic cooperation and integration in other world regions for instance South-East Asia (ASEAN) better into perspective.

授業方法 Course Format	This course will continue in an on-demand format after Monday, October 11, until the end of the semester. When the number of registered students is finalized and the classroom environment standards are met, the class will be held face-to-face. If the standards are not met, the course will continue to be offered in an on-demand or/and online format for health and safety reasons. Lecture format. PPP presentation. Students are expected to work on the prep work for each class before coming to class.
