Brief background description of Consul General Edward K.H. Dong A graduate of the University of California at Berkeley, with a Juris Doctor degree, Mr. Dong entered the Foreign Service in June 1978. He has been mainly dealing with East Asian issues as Staff Assistant in the Bureau of East Asian and Pacific Affairs, as a member of the Policy Planning Staff, and so on. He also has served in US embassies in Mexico, Korea and Singapore and in American Institute in Taiwan. He served as Consul General in the US Consulate General in Guangzhou, China for 3 years from 2003. He has been Consul General of the US Consulate General in Osaka-Kobe, Japan since 2008.
