- In the "Remarks" section for AY 2019 and AY 2020, enter the number of students whose withdrawal was decided from April to December of the following year (at the time of finalization).

For "Of which Repeaters (B)"do not include students planning to take subjects over an extended period, students on a leave of absence, students whose advancement was delayed due to a leave of absence, students away on study abroad programs, or students whose advancement was delayed due to study abroad. For "Of which Withdrawals (C)" include students who were expulsed.

For those classified as Repeaters that withdraw during their repeating year, only include them in "Of which are Withdrawals (C)," and not "Of which are Repeaters (B)."

For professional universities that use semesters for their courses, devide them into first and second semesters by department.
