Co-operation between the Public and Private sector in community welfare planning

ABSTRACT

One definition of co-operation is "thinking together, working together, taking up the risk together for the common purpose". According to this definition, co-operation between the public and the private sectors necessitates that they establish a relationship of equality and become jointly responsible for the common purpose.

The question is then how co-operation between these sectors is possible in community welfare planning? This paper examine the substance of co-operation between these sectors by focusing on the participation of residents in health and welfare planning for elderly people.

I have classified participation of residents in the process of the health and welfare planning for elderly people into five types and made clear the possibility of cooperation between the sectors in every one of these types.

The purpose of this study is to investigate the conditions for co-operation between the public and private sectors in the area of social welfare.
