

An Evaluation of the Municipal Angel Plan from the View of the Child Welfare Practitioner. (2)

ABSTRACT

This article as the second segment of a series, presents a case study of the planning process of a municipal Angel Plan implemented in T-city which is in the south-east of Hyogo prefecture. The planning process includes (1) planning implementation structure and (2) planning implementation process.

As for (1), writer examines ① the vertical central-local administrative relationships and ② the horizontal relationships of municipal policy making systems with congress, committee, residents and so on. The background of the national Angel Plan, contents, structure, and “Child Making Growth Plan” with its relation to the “Children’s Future 21 Plan” Report, and what got the “Child Making Growth Plan” implemented as the “municipal angel plan” by the authorities, as well as the character of “Arranging Foundation of Child Nurturing Environment Action” reflect the central-local structural relationships. And the actual environment of T-city is described.

As for (2), from July 1996 beginning with a consultation committee (shingi-kai) to 1998, the planning implementation process is summarized in tables.
