An Evaluation of the Municipal Angel Plan from the View of a the Child Welfare Practitioner (3)

⟨An Analysis of T-city's Planning Process⟩

ABSTRACT

This article as the third segment of a series, analyzes the process of developing T-city's municipal Angel plan. The planning process includes the following steps; A: the first move & creation of an agenda, B: draft making, C: intra-office ajustment conference, D: consultation with the committee, E: reflect on public opinion, F: adopt committee's plan, G: realize the action plan, H: implement the plan, I: prepare staff, programs & services. And add to those items, J: evaluation of the planner. The writer presents the characteristics of each step of the process. The view point of these characteristics has two focuses, ① is that from central-local administrative relationships, and ② is from the municipal policy making systems. In addition, information from an interview is used in ③ to describe the planner's awareness about the making process and planning. Each characteristic from A to J has 30 items. The planner's awareness has 13 items.

As for the contents of T-city's Angel Plan, the writer introduces it by drawing the outline of the ideal plan & the action plan. At last the writer presents the characteristics of the planning implementation process of the municipal Angel plan in 20 summarized points. The conclusion is that The Child Nurturing Plan as a municipal administrative plan has inevitably been influenced by administration processes, so we need it to be explicit from the view of the practitioner.
